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DEPARTMENT ACTIVITIES

Department of Education (B.El.Ed. Programme)

The department of Elementary Education began the new session 2008-09 with the inaugural address by Prof. Poonam Batra (Ex-coordinator of B.El.Ed., Department of Education, University of Delhi) who delivered a lecture on 'Elementary Education in India – Problems and Solutions' highlighting the utility of this course and its challenges. To help the 1st year students cope well with their syllabus, theatre and craft workshops were organized from time to time. Visits to the Doll Museum, Craft Museum and Bal Bhawan facilitated them to organize a craft exhibition. "Self Development Workshop" and various "Story Telling Workshops" were organized for the II year students of this programme. The innovative school visit to Shikshantar in Gurgaon was a great learning opportunity for the B.El.Ed. III year students. The School Internship Programme was successfully completed by the IV year students. The students also attended various lectures organized by the Department of Education. Besides, the IV year students actively participated in a workshop on "Writing of reflective journal" at Gargi College. The placement of the last year students is also encouraging. While most of them have been appointed as full time primary teachers in private and government schools, some of our students are pursuing post-graduation courses in Sociology, History, Environment Sciences, English, Political Science and Education. A few students are working with NGO's.

Department of Social Work

- : Organized orientation programme for freshers from 16.7.2008 – 23.7.2008 wherein various resource persons were invited to acquaint the students with the scope of the course. Educational visits were also organized on this occasion to give the new comers a feel of the field work.

- : Organized eight day trip to Bangluru in September 2008.
- : Diwali Mela, a regular feature of B.S.W. Department was held in October on the theme of Global Warming. Colourful cultural programmes and Magic Show attracted a lot of attention and appreciation.
- : On 18th November, 2008 the 'Pearl Gupta Memorial Debate' was held on the first death anniversary of Pearl Gupta. The Family Counselling was inaugurated on this occasion. The function was graced by Prof. Sanjay Bhatt, (HOD, Department of Social Work), Prof. Kohli and Prof. Anjali Gandhi (Jamia Milia Islamia).
- : The Department of Social Work in collaboration with FCW, Psychology and B.El.Ed. Departments, coordinated by Dr. Beena Reji would be closely associated with Global Funds to fight AIDS, TB and Malaria. This programme aims at enhancing human and institutional capacities of HIV counseling training institutes in India.
- : Dr. R. Nalini of B.S.W. was granted UGC Major Research Project on "Emotional Violence Against Women in the Work Place".
- : A workshop on HIV/AIDS and Human Rights organized on 4th December, 2008.
- : A team of 10 B.S.W. students visited Bihar to support Udai Project – for Bihar Flood Relief.

Department of Commerce

The Commerce Department organized a two-day seminar on 'Emerging issues in Commerce and Business' on 26th and 27th September, 2008. It was packed with intellectually stimulating and brain storming sessions by some of the most sought after names in the Department of Commerce. The Seminar was inaugurated by Prof. Sanjay Jain (Head of the Department, Commerce). In his key note address he talked at length on the 'Mantra of success in a corporate world'. Prof. Jawaharlal and Prof. A. K. Seth addressed the issues of 'Activity based Costing' and 'Need to professionalize education in business' respectively. The session on 'Misleading Advertising' by Dr. Gayatri Verma and Dr. Anita Malhotra were well received by the students. Sh. Narendra Singh, Director BIS addressed the house on 'Consumer Protection'. The Business Communication workshop conducted by Dr. Anjana Neira Dev, Principal, Vivekanand College along with her team of Dr. Archana Mathur, Dr. Tullika Prasad and Dr. Tasneem Shahnaz was fun filled and informative. The highly interactive session was a wonderful exposure for our students.

Department of Hindi Journalism

The session 2008-09 began with an orientation programme for the I year students where they got an opportunity to interact with the old students who have now successfully made a place

for themselves in the world of media. To give the students a first hand knowledge of the curriculum, experts from the Print and Electronics Media were invited to deliver special lectures from time to time. Mr. Manish Sharma, News Anchor from Star News, Mr. Arvind Kumar from 'Univarta', Mr. Sanjay Kundan, Senior Editor, Navbharat Times and renowned story writer, shared their pearls of wisdom with the budding journalists of Aditi. Dr. Harish Arora and Dr. Sanjay Singh Baghel were also invited to deliver special lectures. A 'Hasya Kavi Sammelan' by Hindi Academy was successfully organized in the college on Diwali. In the month of September, 2008 the B.H.J. students were also taken on an educational trip to 'Univarta'. A seminar on 'Sports Journalism – Changing Perspectives' was organized on 4th January, 2009 where the students actively participated in various discussions.

A media workshop on 'New Journalism' was also organized which offered a platform for the students to interact with renowned journalists and experts in the field of Media who briefed the students on the emerging trends in Media.

Department of Geography

The Department of Geography is basking in glory of the accomplishments of its students in securing the first and second positions in the University. This achievement is even more special for this feat has been achieved in the very first year since the Geography (Honours) Course was introduced in our college.

A special lecture by Dr. S. K. Bandooni, Associate Professor Shaheed Bhagat Singh College (Evening) on "Conservation of Energy Resources in Developing Countries" was highly appreciated by the students and the faculty. 32 students from B.A.(Honours) II year and B.El.Ed. II year (Geography students) visited Goa as part of their field excursion with three faculty members from 5th January – 13th January, 2009. The focus was to study the tourism industry in Goa. The Association for Geographical Studies (AGS) Northern zone in collaboration with the Department of Geography, Swami Shradhanand College organized two lectures at Aditi during the first week of February 2009. The lectures were on "Population pressure on Natural Resources". By Mr. Nitesh Kumar, Director NAM Institute of Professional Studies Delhi and "Role of Remote Sensing and GIS in Natural Resources Management" by Mr. Khuspal, Director, GEO Solutions, Gurgaon.

About 50 students visited Asola Wildlife Sanctuary, Faridabad on 7th February, 2009 along with other members of AS, Northern Zone. Three lecturers and five students have visited Bhopal, Sanchi and Udaigiri as a part of the AGS annual activities.

Department of Family & Child Welfare

It has been an eventful year for the FCW Department packed with numerous workshops and visits. The first term began with visits to different NGO's including SOS Village, Bawana and government programmes in the field of child and women welfare, namely MCH and Anganwadi (ICDS). In the second term, Art and craft Workshops were conducted by different resource

person. The students got a hands on experience of preparing educational toys and puppets from waste and low cost indigenous material. The students made floating wax and gel candles and actively participated in the Diya Decoration Competition. These were then put for sale and “Light a Diya and enlighten a life” was promoted, the proceeds of which were forwarded to the Bihar Flood Relief Work. The extra educational aids in the department were sent for the children affected by flood. In the third term, the students visited ‘Prayas’ – an NGO working for juvenile delinquents and YWCA – working for the empowerment of women and children. The FCW Day was celebrated on 13th February, 2009. It was an interdisciplinary activity in collaboration with the Department of Nutrition and Health Education. The theme was “giving Children a Voice” focusing on the developmental and nutritional needs of children. On this occasion, poster making, innovative toy making, bulletin board, decoration, rangoli, low cost nutritive diets for children and many such activities were organized by the two departments. Dr. Rachna Bhardwaj, Social Activist and Dr. Deepa Bajaj (activist in the field of child welfare) graced the occasion.

Students' Union Advisory Committee

The Students' Union Advisory Committee comprising of Dr. Neerja Deswal (Convener) and Ms. Leena Sehgal (Co-convener) worked in close co-operation with the student elected body for the all round progress of the college. It celebrated the Founders Day for the first time on 5th August, 2008. Mr. Dibang, Executive Producer NDTV presided over the function and applauded the efforts of the institution in imparting higher education to rural girls, most of whom are first generation learners. Library Committee

The library committee under the convenership of Dr. Bharti Mohan took an initiative for the effective and efficient functioning of the library. It has actively persuaded the computerization of the library. In this regard, various computer experts were invited to present a demo before the faculty and non-teaching staff. Conscious effort was made to procure quality books and journals in the library. A grant of Rs.1,60,000.00 was made available for this purpose. For the first time with the motivation and encouragement from the Principal an exhibition was organized where publishers from all parts of Delhi displayed books on different subjects. The event was inaugurated by Shri Jal Singh Rana, Chairman, Governing Body.

Cultural Committee

The Cultural Committee with Dr. Suniti Datta and Dr. Rajeev Kaur along with their team members worked the year round to organize a cultural extravaganza in 2008-09. They set the mood rolling with Talent Hunt show on 1st August, 2008 where the students immersed in a gala galore of festivity with each trying to outdo the other in various events organized on this occasion. The voice of Aditi Ms. Chandrima Datta mesmerized the audience and bagged the first prize. The group songs too enthralled the listeners and were indeed commendable for their zest and energy. The dance competition was a rocking success thanks to a bunch of young enthusiasts whose choice of pulsating foot tapping music and colourful costumes left everyone spell bound. The first prize went to Ms. Seema of B.A.(H) Geography. The Talent Hunt, the first of its kind at Aditi was a welcome effort of the cultural committee.

The cultural committee also celebrated Republic Day to mark the 59th year of India's Republic. The patriotic songs sung on this occasion instilled nationalistic feelings amongst all present. The motivating speeches by the Chairman of the Governing Body and Principal (OSD) Dr. Saroj Gulati added patriotic fervor to the event.

Placement Cell

The Placement cell is in its nascent stage and has expanded under the convenership of Dr. Bhawna Rajput. The cell has successfully conducted a series of pre-placement talks and

recruitment interviews for final year students of Arts and Commerce stream. It has impressive achievements during the current year 2008-09 to boast of :

National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.)
